

Spring City Council Work Meeting
January 15, 2009
6:30 p.m.

Attending: Adam Burningham, Cliff Mott, Ryan Syme, Emilee Sanderson [Messenger], Matt Francks, Dennis Watson.

Expression of Choice: There was no expression of choice.

Roll Call: Mayor Eldon Barnes, Council members Pamela Anderson, Boyd Mickel, Thomas Allred, Bryan Sorensen. Council member Michael Workman was not present.

Dog Ordinance

Council member Anderson presented the Animal Control Ordinance and would like to rename it to a Dog Ordinance. Council discussed the need for a dog run definition and questioned the feet required from other's property to keep disturbances under control. Council discussed placing a dog run 50 – 75 feet,

Council discussed kennels and decided that no kennels would be allowed in the city. Vicious animals were discussed as well as destruction of dogs when taken to the pound.

Animal Ordinance

Council member Anderson presented a Large Animal Ordinance that would allow animals in the city but with certain restrictions. Council discussed lot maintenance and grazing periods.

Cliff Mott stated that he had neighbors that had 7 horses in 10 x 10 pens and they were not taken care of properly. Mr. Mott stated that his neighbors also had other animals that created a nuisance for him during the year.

Council discussed nuisances and the area required for corrals to properly take care of animals. Council discussed animal units and how many could be allowed on property.

Mainstreet Ordinance

Council member Allred stated that the city needed to address this ordinance and try to reword it so the city could take care of mainstreet in the Commercial Zone. Council member Mickel stated that something needed to be addend for Snow Removal to combat future problems. Council member Mickel also stated that Garbage Cans needed to be addressed, as well as vehicles that ware parked on city right of way.

Council member Mickel stated that he would have these changes ready for next council meeting.

Water Ordinance

Mayor Barnes stated that the issue concerning the water meter at the Trailer Court needed to be addressed. Mayor Barnes stated that to get this

installed a section would need to be added to the ordinance so that in the future there would be no legal issues. Council made one change and slated a Public Hearing for February 5th, before regular council meeting.

Buffer Zone

Mayor Barnes would like a decision from council concerning the buffer zone. Council member Mickel stated he thought the city should pursue the issue for the possibility of future annexation to guard the city for roads.

Mayor Barnes stated that he would like council to consider a Surplus Property Ordinance so the city could get rid of things that were worn out in the future. Mayor Barnes stated he would have a drafted ordinance for the council to review during the next council meeting.
