

**February 12, 2009**  
**Spring City Council Work Meeting**  
**6:30 p.m.**

**Attending:** Joan Durfey, Doug Durfey, Dennis Watson.

**Roll Call:** Mayor Eldon Barnes was excused. Mayor Pro-Temp Boyd Mickel presided over meeting. Council members, Michael Workman, Pamela Anderson, and Thomas Allred were present. Council member Bryan Sorensen was absent.

**Dog Ordinance**

Council discussed some proof errors and changed breaded to bred. Council discussed leash lengths and took out the 6 foot requirement. Council discussed the definition for Kennel/Dog Run and took out the definition as well as Commercial Kennel. Council made changes to the Owner/Custodian definition, Number of dogs at a residence or per household, on premises or in their care. Council discussed dog runs and decided at least 50 feet from property. Council took out possession of Wild Animals. Council changed Animal to Dog throughout the ordinance.

**Mainstreet Ordinance**

Council discussed parking vehicles on streets as well as on Mainstreet. Council discussed snow removal and damage to the roads done by citizens by scraping. Council discussed snow removal from fire hydrants and how citizens should address this issue. Council discussed garbage canisters and dumpsters that are placed out on the road. Council discussed the responsibility of water right owners and who was responsible for damage to roads by not cleaning out ditches. Council discussed drainage throughout the city and the city property citizens where responsible for ditch upkeep. Council discussed off-street parking and drainage. Council discussed mainstreet and working in alliance with property owners to help maintain mainstreet.

**Animal Ordinance**

Council discussed if all animals should be licensed. Council discussed eliminating Part 2 of the drafted Ordinance. Council discussed land limits for animals and pasture management. Dennis Watson inquired if the ordinance should be included in the Land and Use Ordinance.

**Surplus Property Ordinance**

Council discussed a form that would accompany the request to dispose of property.
